## Intercultural Community Weekend

ICW is an overnight retreat where College Nine students deepen their awareness and connection to College Nine's theme of International and Global Perspectives. Through interactive exercises and small group discussions, students are given the opportunity to learn more about themselves and others, and develop intercultural sensitivity and awareness.

## IAG - International Affairs Group

Based out of the International Living Center, the International Affairs Group (IAG) is an opportunity for all College Nine and College Ten community members to engage in lively discussions about important current international issues with one another through guest speakers, film, literature, media, and personal experiences.

## Terry Freitas Cafe

Terry Freitas Cafe was created by students who wanted a chill spot in which to hang out and build community. Open daily and every night, you can come here to hang out with friends, study for classes, play pool or board games or attend a variety of special programs such as open mics, pool tournaments, or karaoke nights.

## Community Garden Class & Club

Students can also enroll in the 2-unit class in Spring, which is a hands-on introduction to ecological horticulture.
